

Computer/Internet Use Agreement

Dominion Academy of Dayton (DA) provides a computer laboratory with Internet access and printers for student use. Authorized students may use these computers as tools to complete a wide range of school and approved extracurricular assignments/projects. Direct supervision by school personnel of each student using the computers is not always possible. Students are expected to use these resources in a manner consistent with this contract and will be held responsible for their use. We encourage parents to discuss with their children their own expectations for their child's Internet use. Students may receive permission to access DA's wireless networks upon accepting the terms and conditions in this document.

<u>Internet activities that are not permitted:</u>

- Searching, viewing, or retrieving materials that are sexually explicit (or otherwise inappropriate or not consistent with Christian standards), profane, violence-promoting, or illegal materials is not permitted.)
- Copying, saving, or redistributing copyrighted materials (Users should assume that all material is copyrighted unless explicitly noted.)
- Subscription to any services or ordering any kids of goods or services;
- Sharing of the student's home address, phone number, or any other personal information;
- Any activity that violates a school rule or a local, state, or federal law.

Computer Lab Expectations:

- Computer classes always have priority use of the DA computer labs.
- Do not alter or damage computer lab computers, peripherals or software.
- No personal software of any type is to be used on DA computer lab equipment without prior approval.
- Students are only allowed to use computers designated for student use. Students may not use staff computers or printers.
- No food or drink in computer labs.

If a student has any questions about whether a specific activity is permitted, he or she should ask a teacher or staff member. If a student accidentally accesses inappropriate material, he or she must terminate access immediately. Report such incidents to a teacher or staff member.

Violation of the terms of this agreement will result in suspension of revocation of a student's access to the Internet and computer use. Any action taken by a student which is a violation of school standards will be subject to school disciplinary actions. Your signature(s) on the attached agreement is (are) legally binding and indicates the party (parties) who signed has (have) read the terms and conditions carefully and understand(s) their significance.
